NOVA SCOTIA ASSOCIATION OF CBDCS

Community Business Development Corporations (CBDCs) are not-for-profit organizations that help strengthen and diversify rural communities by providing financing, business counselling and training to entrepreneurs. There are 13 CBDCs serving the needs of small businesses in rural Nova Scotia. Each CBDC is locally owned and operated. Investment decisions are made by local volunteers who are sensitive to the needs of the community.

SERVICES INCLUDE

Financial assistance, generally to a maximum of \$150,000, available in the forms of loans, loan guarantees and equity financing. In certain circumstances, CBDCs can provide financial assistance that exceeds \$150,000.

Business counselling and advice for small businesses and people interested in starting a business. We want businesses to succeed and we give high priority to the advisory role of our mandate. Advisory assistance usually takes the form of guidance and coaching, and sometimes advocating on behalf of our clients to other lending establishments or regulatory agencies.

Business management skills training to individuals and small business owners/managers.

The Government of Canada provides CBDCs with some operational support through the national Community Futures program. In Nova Scotia, the program is administered by the Atlantic Canada Opportunities Agency. CBDCs are part of a national network of 267 corporations, each dedicated to the development of rural Canada. The 13 Nova Scotia CBDCs are members of the Nova Scotia Association of CBDCs, an organization that supports the common needs of the network. Through the Association, CBDCs regularly meet to discuss local business development opportunities, best practices and operational issues. Through provincial committees, volunteers and staff work together on various initiatives such as professional development and marketing activities. The Association also manages several business development programs, including a Consulting Advisory Services Program, a Launch Export Program and SkillsonlineNS.ca.

HIGHLIGHTS

Nova Scotia's 13 CBDCs approved 486 loans totaling \$35,934,121 in investments to small and medium-sized businesses. These investments resulted in the creation and/ or maintenance of over 1,500 jobs and helped businesses leverage \$32,514,460 from other sources. Forty percent of the applications approved were for new start-ups.

CBDCs have access to an Atlantic wide Entrepreneurial Training Fund. This program provides funding support for business owners to improve their business management skills. In 2022-23, 66 training sessions were supported. The Association also manages the Skillsonlinens.ca project, an online training platform made available through the Department of Labour Skills and Immigration. Over 40,000 users have signed up and have completed thousands of courses (all available at no cost to Nova Scotia residents). PROVINCIAL PROJECTS

Consulting Advisory Services (CAS)

CBDCs have access to a consulting advisory services program for small business owners and non-profit organizations in rural Nova Scotia. This program provides 75% of consulting fees to a maximum of \$5,000 for diagnositc assessments, export readiness assistance and business management skills assessment. In 2022-23 CBDCs approved 64 applications for a total of \$306,769 in assistance.

SkillsonlineNS.ca

The Association manages the agreement between the Department of Labour Skills and Immigration and Bluedrop ISM. The project launched in October 2012 and has seen over 40,000 users added in that time. The platform offers free online training and the ability to track employee training. This past year a custom WHMIS course was added to the platform.

Spark Innovation Program

The Association once again managed the delivery of the Spark program. There were 45 applicants from rural Nova Scotia and 7 winners were awarded a total of \$270,000 in prize money to help them turn their business ideas into reality.

Launch Export

This program is a project of the Atlantic Trade and Investment Growth Agreement, it is a comprehensive export readiness initiative that aims to build export culture among SMEs in the Atlantic Provinces through export coaching and training and an educational trade mission. Thirty companies participated.

Workplace Education


The Association took on a new project in 2022. They provide support for the Workplace Education Initiative and work with the Department of Labour Skills and Immigration to address training needs across the province.

Community Capacity Fund

The objective of the Community Capacity Fund (CCF) is to build strategic capacity as it relates to regional development initiatives in rural areas of Nova Scotia. The CCF assists industry/sector associations, municipalities, social enterprises and not-forprofit organizations initiate small-scaled activities that are limited in scope, timesensitive, require financial assistance to be undertaken, and usually assists these organizations to address timely issues, opportunities and/or challenges through the support of professional outside expertise. A new project began in 2022 and eight applications were approved.


Innovation Canada Webinars

The Association organized a series of webinars for Community Futures clients across the country to learn more about the programs and services offered by Innovation Canada. Over 125 CF staff attended the train the trainer sessions and 536 clients attedended the 10 webinars (offered in English and French).

OVER THREE YEARS (INCLUDES RRRF)




